

# November 2nd, 2021 Voter Guide

## **Amendment 78 - Legislative Authority for Spending State Money** **(Vote YES)**

- The Governor, the Attorney General, and unelected administrators in state agencies currently spend large amounts of custodial money, often without public input or accessible public records. **This will increase transparency in how custodial money is spent.**

## **Proposition 119 - Learning Enrichment and Academic Progress Program** **(No Position)**

- Allows public money to be directed to private out-of-school service providers instead of invested directly in public schools. **Benefits Charter Schools.** Funded by an increase in the Marijuana sales tax.

## **Proposition 120 - Property Tax Assessment Rate Reduction** **(Vote YES)**

- Reduces the Multifamily property tax rate from 7.15% to 6.5% and the Lodging Properties tax rate from 29% to 26.4%. This will provide relief to property owners, ease pressure on rents, and encourage investment to address Colorado's housing shortage.
