

2026 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Resolutions

To be considered by the Resolutions Committee:

1. Only eligible participants attending a Caucus may submit a Resolution.
2. The submitter of a resolution must provide their full legal name, address, phone number, email address, and precinct number.
3. Each resolution shall be in the format of: "WHEREAS... IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT...."
4. Resolutions must be typed if submitted on paper or submitted by email to resolutions@larimergop.org
5. All resolutions must be received by Monday, 3/9/26 by 8:00 p.m. Paper resolutions may be presented at the Caucus but must be emailed to the committee.

The Resolutions Committee has final say on all issues regarding resolutions. Only resolutions submitted by the deadline above, in the proper format, for State and National Party Platforms will be considered for submission. Late resolutions will not be accepted.
